COACH'S CORNER

Raphael Nadal has just won an incredible 12th title at the Barcelona Open, and in doing so he becomes the 1st player in the Open Era to notch up 450 wins on not 1, but 2



surfaces used on tour - hard courts and clay. The points earned also bump him back up to World no.2, just behind Novak Djokovic. So you'd think during this campaign for wins, titles and records that he'd take any easy breaks he can get, right?! Well, after his straight sets win over Cameron Norrie in the quarterfinals, instead of heading to the locker room to celebrate with his team, stretch and cool down after a job well done, he immediately went to the practice courts to hit some more. This is what he said during his on-court interview, "I played well at the beginning...then I stopped a little bit [in the middle], something that cannot happen, especially tomorrow."

We all know what it feels like to win, and win well in matches. The reward and satisfaction knowing what we did won us the match, rather than our opponent simply losing it. And whilst I always say it is good to make mistakes to learn from them, the attitude Nadal demonstrated after his match last week, shows why he is the champion he is. This attitude can be adopted by anyone playing at any level - always looking for ways to improve and learn, regardless of the scoreboard. With Senior Club Championships kicking off very soon, use the time you have now to see what you can learn, not just from your losses, but also from your wins



SPONSOR'S CORNER



Some staggering statistics to report ... median prices for residential property across New Zealand increased by 24.3% from \$665,000 in March 2020 to \$826,300 in March 2021 a new record high for the country. The number of residential properties sold in March across New Zealand increased by 31.2% when compared to the same time last year (from 7,408 to 9,721) - the highest for the month of March in 14 years and the highest annual percentage change in 3 months.

Auckland's median days to sell decreased from 33 to 31 days, the lowest for the month of March in 6 years. There is some market speculation that the rate by which values are increasing may slow mid-year following recent legislative changes.
