
Review of Previous Minutes

Treasurer's Report to 29 February 2024

Profit and Loss Statement

- Attached is the Profit and Loss (P&L) for the year-to-date (YTD) to 29 February 2024. <u>Operating Profit</u> (before depreciation & Grant Revenue) is \$26.6k (February 2023 Profit \$26.5k). This has the comparison to the last 4 years.

- I have also attached a **monthly** P&L, which shows the transactions this month (including 3 months prior and YTD).
- <u>Subs</u> 10 new juniors and 1 family sub since the 'bring-a-friend' day. Subs YTD \$51.8k (YTD February 2023 \$53.1k a minor 2.3% drop)
- <u>Expenses</u> Attached is a listing from Xero of the payments made since my last report, from 31January 2024 29 February 2024.

Balance Sheet

Currently have \$93.2k in the bank (February 2023 \$87.3k), \$64.6k on two term deposits and \$28.6k in the operating account. Term deposits mature on 13 April 2024 and 8 July 2024.


Coach's Report - Jac Wardrope


Bring-a-Friend morning on the 10th February went reasonably well, 175 attending that morning gaining a few new members.




Health and Safety

Continuous Spouting HB Tournament


Discussion held in committee on how this will be run going forward. Remains the same this year going forward this may change in future.
