Safe Tennis Update – Jac reported this has been done and all coaches have completed their paperwork. Stacey to email Sean to enquire where any responses get sent.


Coaches Contract – Jac has returned a signed contract.

Treasurer's Report to 30 April 2024

Profit and Loss Statement

- Attached is the <u>Profit and Loss</u> (P&L) for the year-to-date (YTD) to 30 April 2024. Operating Profit (before depreciation & Grant Revenue) is \$22.4k (April 2023 Profit \$18.4k). This has the comparison to the last 4 years.
- I have also attached a Monthly P&L, which shows the transactions this month (including 3 months prior and YTD).
- Subs nothing material to report.
- <u>Expenses</u> Attached is a listing from Xero of the payments made since my last report, 1 March 2024 30 April 2024.

Balance Sheet

• Currently have \$90.2k in the bank (April 2023 \$77.6k), \$65.8k on two term deposits and \$24.5k in the operating account. Term deposits mature on 8 July 2024 and 13 October 2024.

General Business

- 1. I have ordered & paid for the 4th bench seat.
- 2. I have submitted the Accountability Reports for the 2 Grants received this year. \$2,000 from the Lion Foundation, and \$5,000 from Grassroots Trust Limited.
- 3. I submitted the Insurance claim for the broken lock and stolen speaker. We received \$682.62 in March, after the excess of \$1,000 was deducted.
- 4. The New Zealand Sotheby's International Realty 5-year sponsorship of one of the shipping containers is up 1 September 2024.
- 5. The NOW NZ Limited rolling 1-year sponsorship of one of the shipping containers is up 1 November 2024.



Life Membership Badges


