

Treasurers Report – Nic Holland


Treasurer's Report to 31 January 2024

Profit and Loss Statement

- Attached is the Profit and Loss (P&L) for the year-to-date (YTD) to 31 January 2024. **Operating Profit** (before depreciation & Grant Revenue) is \$25.5k (January 2023 Profit \$26.2k). This has the comparison to the last 4 years. I have the TNZ affiliation fee in there based on a quote, awaiting the final invoice.
- I have also attached a **monthly** P&L, which shows the transactions this month (including 3 months prior and YTD).
- <u>Subs</u> nothing material to report for the period since the last meeting. Subs YTD \$50.7k (YTD January 2023 \$52.5k 3.5% drop)
- <u>Expenses</u> Attached is a listing from Xero of the payments made since my last report, from 1 December 2023 31 January 2024.

Balance Sheet

- Currently have \$97.8k in the bank (January 2023 \$86.3k), \$64.6k on two term deposits and \$33.2k in the operating account.




Sotheby's container broken into. It's been rekeyed, alike with the NOW Container. See GB for further details.

Easter Court Hire


