# Treasurers And Financial Report - Nic Holland

## Treasurer's Report to 30 April 2022

### Profit and Loss Statement

- Attached is the Profit and Loss (P&L) from 1 June 2021 to 30 April 2022. Net Profit (after depreciation) to 30 April 2022 is \$35,006.06. This has the comparison of the last 4 years.
- Attached also is a **monthly** P&L, which show the transactions since our last meeting (including the 3 months prior and YTD).
- Coaching costs for the month are the Term 1 Coach payments for the Saturday morning coaching - \$4,225.00

### Balance Sheet

- Attached is the Balance Sheet as at 30 April 2022.
- There is \$34k in the bank, \$22.1k on term deposit maturing 8 July 2022. There is \$2,880.30 of cash to be deposited (sitting in 'Other Accounts Receivable'.
- There is also a large GST refund of approximately \$11k due (refer Current Assets), basically as a result of the Court resurfacing costs. The next GST return is to 31 May 2022 - due in June 2022.

April Tennis Holiday Programme was completed in the first week of the school holidays: The three sessions were well received by players and parents. Around 20 attended each morning.

'Games and Drills along with Eats and Beats' with Jac on Mondays from 5pm to 6.30pm; Jac has changed format to '**Matchplay Monday**' running from 5.30 to 6.30pm Six courts should suffice and will fit in with the proposed senior Monday evening tennis. In the past a \$20 payment for each session has been made from the club to Jac plus kids taking part have paid \$5 (and have got food which is not going to continue), however Jac is looking at introducing small cash prizes.

Payment of \$100 from club required for the following Junior Coaches who completed the three day TennisNZ Coaching course from 18<sup>th</sup> to 20<sup>th</sup> March: Logan Margerison, Chris Bonthron, Charlie Titter and Clara Newman.

Congratulations to Hunter Every who is not only our Junior Champion and Senior Champion, but is also now the Hawkes Bay Residential Singles Champion.

Looking ahead:

Jac is going to revitalise our Red Ball sessions for next season

Jac is aiming to go into some of the local Primary Schools to promote tennis and our Junior Programme at the start of next season, hopefully just before we restart – this has not been done for some time and is a great way to get kids involved in our sport.
