Hi all,

It's been a good month of coaching at Greendale post cyclone - much better weather with only one day missed due to high winds and one due to rain.

We had a great turn out a few weekends ago for our Junior Club Champs and the weekend before that for our Greendale Closed Junior Doubles Tournament. Thump Sports kindly supplied some great prizes which the kids were all stoked to get. Courts completely full on both days!

We wrapped up our Saturday Morning Hotshots program last week which was well attended as it has been all season. It's been a great bounce back season for the club with junior numbers and I intend to make sure we keep building. I'll be heading into all the local primary schools in the lead up to next season and Love Tennis to ensure we have maximum exposure.

I have signed us up for Love Tennis 2023 and will be the main gobetween/organiser again - I also put Smithy and Craig on TNZ's backup
