

Treasurer's Report to 30 November 2023

Profit and Loss Statement

Attached is the Profit and Loss (P&L) for the year-to-date (YTD) to 30 November 2023. **Operating Profit** (before depreciation & Grant Revenue) is \$42.1k (November 2022 Profit \$33.9k). This has the comparison to the last 4 years. There are a few timing differences with invoices between the years, i.e TSA affiliation fee.

- I have also attached a **monthly** P&L, which shows the transactions this month (including 3 months prior and YTD).
- <u>Subs</u> \$3.6k of subs this month, \$50.3k YTD. (YTD November 2022 \$51.6k)
- <u>Expenses</u> Paid the 'Lease of land' fee to NCC. Attached is a listing from Xero of the payments made since my last report, from 1 30 November 2023.

Balance Sheet

Currently have \$127.2k in the bank (November 2022 \$104.5k), \$64.6k on two term deposits and \$72.7k in the operating account.

Huge thanks to all those who showed up for the working bee. The hedges look amazing and your hard work is appreciated.



28-10: 160 4-11: 151 11-11: 174 18-11: 150


25-11: rained off

Tony to investigate an alternative attachment for the new water fountain so we can attach a hose.


General Business
