An example of a story

I have just received a score sheet for a one set men's doubles Senior interclub team player registration: 31 August exhibition match between Rod Laver and Ken Rosewell of Australia vs Luis Ayala of Chile and Andres Gimeno of Spain. Rosewell and Laver were top men's singles players in the world.

In the 1940's to 1960's New Zealand hosted many tennis teams from Australia and played many international exhibition Sunday 17 December matches. Some of these were at Lower Hutt tennis club.

This score sheet is notable for the LHTC as the umpire for the Seniors Opening Tournament: Sat 7 October match was Ross Dean who was our Club Captain 1957 -1960 It is incredible that this score sheet featuring top players in the world managed to survive 70+ years.

Sat 2 Sept (PP Sun 3 Sept)



Know the Rules

Double hit rule

Only when there is a deliberate second push does the shot become illegal. Two hits occurring during a continuous swing are not deemed a double hit."

Winning the toss

Rule 9 provides that the winner of the toss can choose to serve or to receive OR can choose which end of the court to play first OR can require the opponent to make the first choice.
