Rule Reminders

A quick refresher on some of the rules of tennis...

- A player calls all shots landing on, or aimed at, the player's side of the net.
- If any part of the ball touches the line the ball is good. A ball 99% out is still 100% good.
- Any ball that cannot be called out is considered to be good.
 A player may not claim a let on the basis of not seeing the ball.
- When a ball from another court enters the playing area, any player on the court affected can call a let as soon as the player becomes aware of the ball.
- Partner's disagreement on calls. If one partner calls the ball out and the other partner sees the ball is good, the ball is good.
- Don't walk behind another court during a point, wait until the point is over.
