What's New?

RESURFACING OF COURTS 5-8

11 years ago the club resurfaced courts 5-8. However, the surface failed prematurely due to issues with the foundations. 2 years ago we filled the worst of the cracks but this just delayed the inevitable. The courts are nearing the point at which they are no longer safe to play on. The committee has decided to undertake a significant project to repair the foundations on the northern side of the net, coat the whole area with 40mm thickness of asphalt and recoat the courts with Plexipave/Synpave.

The expected cost is \$90,000 for the foundation repairs and laying of the asphalt, and then \$45,000 for the resurfacing. We hope that grants will pay for a significant portion of the cost. The timing of the project will be dependent upon availability of contractors, weather and funds. The project must be conducted during the tennis season because both the asphaltting and resurfacing require warm weather.

The project will be disruptive to members but we are confident we will end up with a great playing surface for many years to come. We ask for your patience and understanding as we progress with this necessary work. Information will be communicated to members as it becomes available.

CLUBSPARK – NEW WEBSITE/MEMBERSHIP PLATFORM

Many of the Hutt Valley clubs have already moved to the free ClubSpark platform which is endorsed by Tennis New Zealand, so we decided it was our turn to jump on board. The website is easy to navigate, looks smart and has a court booking option (for use once you have registered). We needed to move our membership data over to the new system to send out email communications and renewal invites. You should have received an email in the last two weeks regarding lights from the new system. Unlike the old system which had the sender as "Promato", (causing confusion among members with some admitting to deleting these as they didn't know they were LHTC member emails), this new system lists the sender as Lower Hutt Tennis Club<mail@clubspark.kiwi> so there is no confusion.

Important Reminders

1. Due to resource consent **lights** are not to be used at all on Sundays, and must be turned off by 10pm Mon – Sat nights. Make sure that you turn the lights dial to off once you have finished, even if they have automatically turned off by the timer.
2. If you **open** the clubhouse, you must close it, or arrange directly with someone else still playing for them to close it up. Do not assume that someone will close it.
3. **Dog** owners, please ensure that any deposits made on the grounds are removed.
4. **Clubhouse** cleaning and tidying up (emptying bins, sweeping/vacuuming the floors, replacing toilet rolls, filling/emptying the dishwasher) are jobs that all members should assist with – we **DO NOT** have a paid cleaner.

We Remember...

It is with sadness that we farewell Noeline Savage, a Life Member, who was very active at Lower Hutt Tennis Club over the years. Noeline is described as "a real lady, quietly spoken and a friend to all members". Noeline has been a Life Member since 1986. Noeline was regularly seen at club meets, was a member of the midweek group (attended the annual Christmas lunch up till 2019), and also helped with the Juniors for many years. Noeline attended the Mid 1970s reunion held in Nov 2018, and is seated fourth from the left (below).



This is how one of our members recalls Noeline's involvement at LHTC:

"I joined LHTC in 1968, when weekends were for tennis, eight courts were used, and players had to 'sit out' games because of numbers. Noeline, and Neil, a wiley player were regulars, with their daughter, Lynne Pearce. Tennis balls came in boxes of one dozen.

About six years later, I remember Noeline and Neil running the junior tennis programme on a Saturday morning, with rostered help from the senior club members (myself, Judy Hicks, Graeme Josephson, Brian Riddell). Names like John and Murray Ansell, Kerry Waddell featured in the junior club champs.

Noeline was there when I started midweek. Always there with an encouraging word, a word of advice at the end of a game, and always a smile on her face as she played. Again, the numbers required players to sit out a game or two, and club members were rostered on 'babysitting' duties."
