Junior interclub

Junior interclub is about to start again and entries are due in this week. As usual, teams are of 4 players, girls/boys, and it is divided into 4 grades:

Primary Entry Grade

Year 6 and under. New players to the game who have a basic ability to play and can score themselves. Under-arm serving is allowed. Team manager assistance should extend to helping keep the score and explaining the rules for this grade.

B Grade

Year 7 & 8 Beginners, & Year 5 and 6 with some experience. Players can rally, serve overarm and understand scoring. Team manager assistance can extend to help keeping the score and explaining rules.

A Grade

Primary and Intermediate players who can play a variety of shots and can have a competent rally.

Championship Grade

Teams with college players (Year 9 only), plus players below Year 9 who are competent at playing a variety of shots and can compete at a high level.
