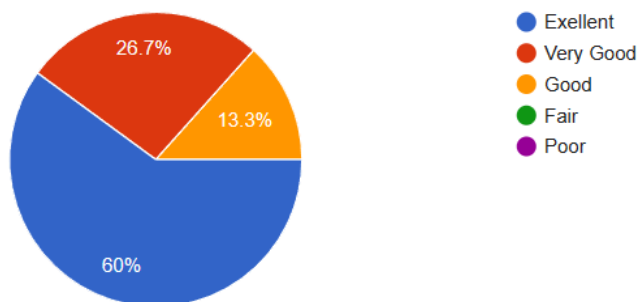
Junior Interclub

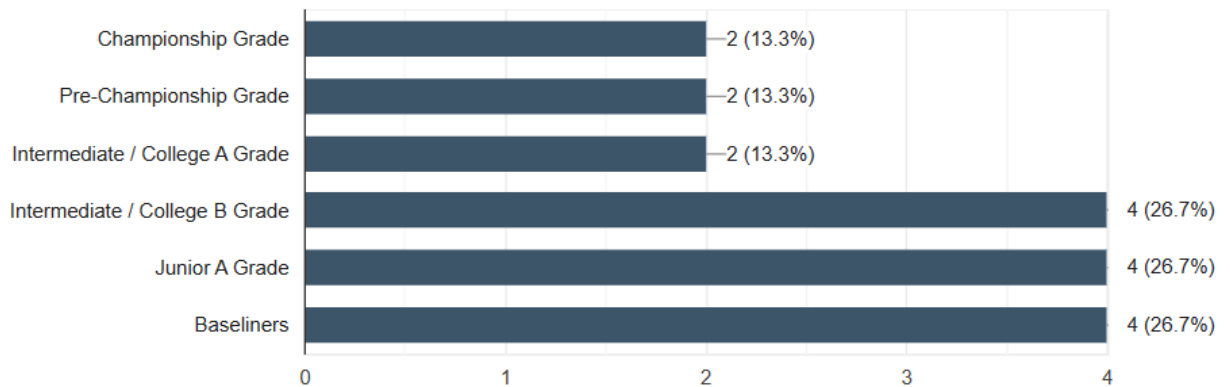

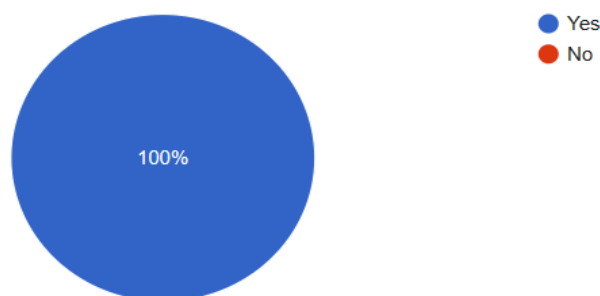

The matches were played in the right spirit. Great challenges each week.

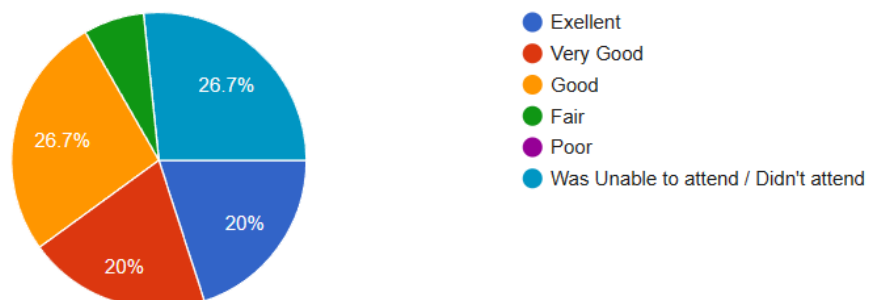
