Entry Fee	<p>\$40/player for FIRST event.</p> <p>\$60/player for SECOND event.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - You may enter TWO age groups (second event additional \$20). - Payment by Paypal required entry to be accepted into the tournament. - 'Player Credit' will be valid if you are currently registered for our postponed T2 event (now in October). Entry Requirements	<u>It is your responsibility to ensure we have received your entry with all the correct information.</u> Tennis Canterbury reserves the right to refuse entries which do not comply with stated requirements.													

Entry Requirements (cont.)	<p>Match Hub Ranking code must be supplied when entering. Please use your Match Hub player code as your Member ID in your online account. If you do not have or do not know your player code, please contact your Club or Association secretary before submitting your entry form. All grade results will be processed for Match Hub ranking points.</p>
Official Ball/Surface	<p>Wilson Official Ball – All age groups except 10's & Under Wilson Green Dot Ball – 10's & Under Surfaces may include but are not limited to Rebound Ace and Plexi-pave</p>
Sign In/Players Meeting	<p>Please report to the venue Tournament Office on arrival each day no later than 30 minutes before your scheduled match for a 8.30am start time with venues being open 7.30am each morning. Players meetings will be held at 8.15am for each age group on their first day of play at the venue.</p>
Seeding	<p>Seeding for all events will be at the discretion of the tournament organizers but will generally be based on the latest available Match Hub Rankings prior to the draw being made.</p>
Match Format	<p>10's : TWO sets to 4 games, must win by 2 clear games. 1st to 7 points tiebreak at 4 all, 3rd set is a Match Tiebreak to 10pts.</p> <p>12's, 14's, 16's, 17+ : TWO sets, 1st to 7 points tie break played at 6 games all. 3rd set is a match tiebreak to 10 points.</p> <p>To win a tiebreaker you must win by two clear points.</p> <p>Tournament Officials have the right, if circumstances make it necessary to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - alter the length of matches. - play on another court / different surface /under lights / indoors.
Number of Matches	<p>Players will get a guarantee of 3 singles matches per event.</p>
Rules	<p>The tournament will be played in accordance with the Rules & Regulations of Tennis NZ, Tennis NZ Player 2019 Code of Conduct and Self Umpiring Rules.</p> <p>-Players must be able to Self Umpire. -Competitors must be prepared to adjudicate if called upon.</p> <p>All players shall dress and present themselves in an appropriate manner for tennis Please refer to the Players Code of Conduct for further clarification.</p>
Spectators	<p>No person other than the match players, adjudicator or referee/court supervisor may be on the courts or converse with the players during play unless given permission by the referee. <i>(Recording or photographing of matches is permitted only under the policy Photographs & Video Policy below)</i></p>
Cafe	<p>Crossroads Cafe will have food/drinks available for the duration of the tournament. This will be upstairs at Wilding Park.</p>

<p>Photographs & Video Policy</p>	<p>Photographing and videoing of matches by competitors/coaches and parents is permitted for matches in which they are personally involved. However, they must obtain the other players permission to photograph or video. If a player is 18 or under, the permission of that player's parent/guardian is required.</p> <p>Such photographing and videoing should be done in a way not to interfere with play or distract/disrupt the opponents and spectators.</p> <p>Stationary cameras mounted on the perimeter fencing cannot be moved during a match.</p> <p>Persons found to be in breach of these conditions may be asked to cease filming of that match.</p> <p>Likewise if a player requests not to be videoed then the request of that player must be upheld.</p> <p>These videos are for the purposes of coaching and improvement by the players and cannot be used in any other way, including the posting to internet websites without the permission of all parties.</p>
<p>Health & Safety</p>	<p>All players under 14 years must have a parent/caregiver present at the tournament facility at all times.</p> <p>Tennis Canterbury Region Inc.
