PLAYER CODE:

MATCH FORMAT**SINGLES:**

8's & 10's will play best of 2 sets to 4. If tie-break is 4 all – then short tie-break to 7. If a set all 10pt tie break for 3rd set. Standard deuce for all singles matches.

Final best of 3 full sets.

8 & 10's Green dot (10's may use yellow balls on consultation with the court sprvsr).

12's + Matches will play three tiebreak sets, with tie-break 6 games all. All feed in plate matches (with the exception of 8's & 10's) will play the best of 2 sets with conventional tie-break at 6 games all.

If one set all, 3rd full set to be played. Standard deuce for all singles matches.

Tournament Officials have the right to alter the length of matches; play on a different surface or under lights if circumstances make it necessary.

WITHDRAWALS/CANCELLATIONS:

Withdrawals after the 19th July 2020 will receive a refund less an administration fee on production of a medical certificate or due to bereavement. TNZ player code of conduct ruling will apply. If the tournament does not proceed due to inclement weather, a refund, less administration fee, will be made.

DRESS CODE:

All players shall dress and present themselves in an appropriate manner for tennis.

Please refer to Tennis NZ Player Handbook or Players Code of Conduct for further clarification.

RULES:

The tournament will be played in accordance with the Rules and Regulations of Tennis NZ, Rules of Tennis and Tennis NZ Player Code of Conduct. Players must be able to self-umpire and players must be prepared to adjudicate if called.

PLAYER BEHAVIOUR:

Tennis NZ Player Code of Conduct will apply. No person other than match players, appointed adjudicator or referee may converse with players unless given permission by the referee. Players must be able to self-umpire. NO parent or spectator to interact with the process of the game.
