AGE GROUPS	8's*, 10's*, 12's, Open Category (grades may be combined at the organizers discretion if insufficient entries are received) - 8's & 10's will play with "Green" balls.		
ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA	Players age as at 31 <sup>st</sup> January 2021		
ENTRY DEADLINE	All entries must be received by <b>11.59pm on Sunday 17th January 2021.</b>  <b>Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the organizers and will incur a late entry charge of \$10 in addition to the normal entry fee.</b>		
ENTRY CONFIRMATION	Confirmed entries will be on the <b>Tournament website</b> on <b>Monday 18th January 2021.</b> Any queries must be received by <b>Tuesday 19th January at 5pm.</b> <b><u>It is your responsibility to ensure we have received your entry.</u></b> Marlborough Tennis reserves the right to refuse any entry which does not comply with stated requirements.

SIGN IN	Please report to Tournament Office at least 30 minutes prior to scheduled start times.		
DRAWS & RESULTS	All draws will be available from <b>Thursday 21 January</b> on Tournament website. Results will be processed for Configure Rankings.		
CONFIGURERANKINGS	Configure Rankings player code must be supplied on the entry form. For online entry please enter your ConfigureRankings player code as you Member ID. <b>If you do not have or do not know your player code, please contact your Club or Association secretary before submitting your entry form.</b>		
SEEDING	Seeding for all events will be at the discretion of the tournament organizers but will generally be based on the latest available ConfigureRankings prior to the draw being made.		



## MATCH FORMAT

### Singles

- All grades (with the exception of the 8's and 10's) will play the best of 2 sets. If one set all, a 10 point match tie breaker game to be played.
- The 8's & 10's will play the best of 2 short sets (to 4). If one set all, a 10 point match tie breaker game to be played.

### Doubles

- All doubles matches (except 8's & 10's) are to be the best of two tiebreak sets with "no ad" deuces and a conventional 7 point tiebreak at six games all. If sets are tied and a 10 point match tie break will be played. (Match Tie Break – 1<sup>st</sup> to 10 points with a margin of 2)
- The 8's & 10's will play best of two tiebreak 'short' sets with "no ad" deuces and a conventional 7 point tiebreak at 4 games all. If sets are tied and a 10 point match tie break will be played. (Match Tie Break – 1<sup>st</sup> to 10 points with a margin of 2).

### PLEASE NOTE:

Tournament Officials have the right to alter the length of matches, play on another court, different surface or under lights if circumstances make it necessary.

## NUMBER OF MATCHES

Players will get at least four matches if entered in both singles and doubles.

## DRESS CODE

All players shall dress and present themselves in an appropriate manner for tennis. Please refer Players Code of Conduct for further clarification

## WITHDRAWALS

Withdrawals after the **Monday 18th January** will receive a refund less an administration fee on production of a medical certificate or due to bereavement. Tennis NZ Player Code of Conduct ruling will apply. If the tournament does not proceed due to inclement weather, a refund, less an administration fee, will be made.

## RULES

The tournament will be played in accordance with the Rules and Regulations of Tennis NZ, Rules of Tennis and Tennis NZ Player Code of Conduct. **Players must be able to self umpire.** Competitors must be prepared to adjudicate if called upon.

## UMPIRING

All players aged 12 and older will be required to umpire some matches. All players should be prepared to be called on to umpire once their current match has been completed.

## SPECTATORS

No person other than the match players, umpires and the referee may be on the courts, or converse with the players during play unless given permission by the referee. (*Videeing of matches is permitted only under the policy below*).

## PROPERTY

All competitors are to take total responsibility for their own equipment. Marlborough Tennis takes no responsibility for lost property.

## CATERING

A canteen will be provided on all days of the event.
