MATCH FORMAT

Singles 10's will play best of 2 sets to 4.

If tie-break 4 all – set tie-break to 7. If a set all 10pt tie break for 3rd set. Standard deuce for all singles matches.

Singles 12's + - matches will play two tiebreak sets, with tie-break at 6 games all. If one set all a 10 point match tie break game to be played. Standard deuce.

Doubles 10'2 - will play best of 2 sets to 4.

If tie-break 4 all – short tie-break to 7. If a set all 10pt tie break for 3rd set. Short deuce.

Doubles 12's + - best of two tiebreak sets with short deuces & tie break at 6 games all. If one set all a Super Tie break (10 point) to be played.

(Tournament Officials have the right to alter the length of matches; play on a different surface or under lights if circumstances make it necessary).

WITHDRAWALS/CANCELLATIONS

Withdrawals after the 10th September 2023 will receive no refund. If the tournament does not proceed due to inclement weather, a refund, less administration fee, will be made.

DRESS CODE All players shall dress and present themselves in an appropriate manner for tennis.
