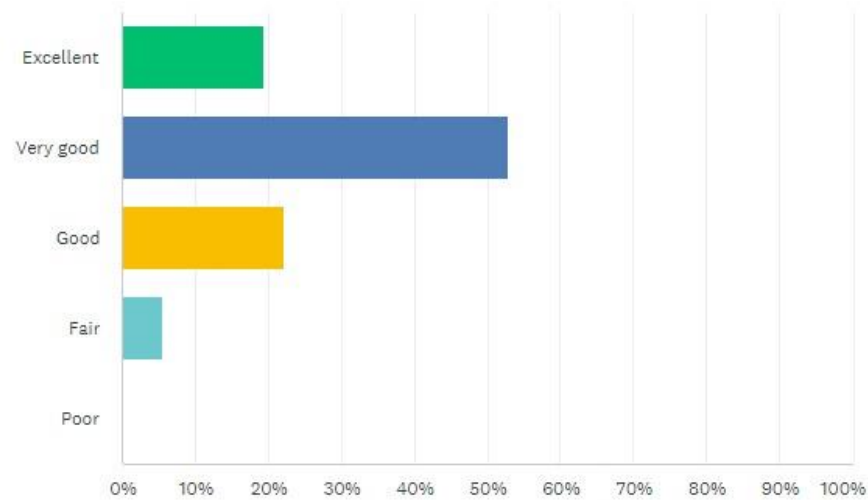



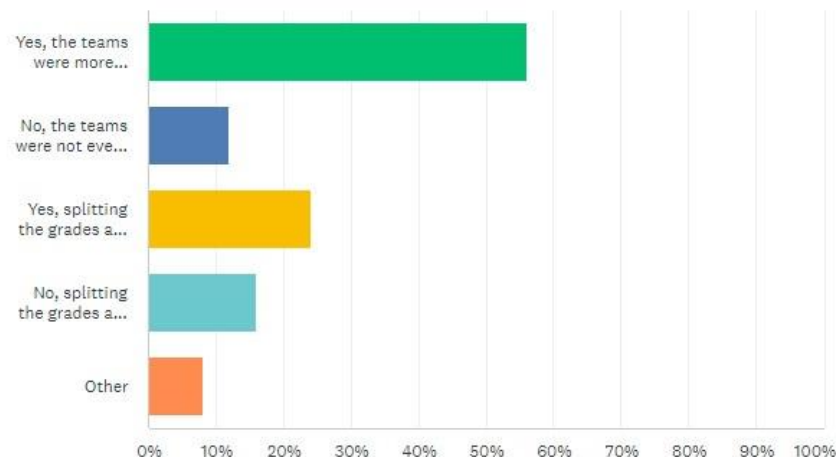

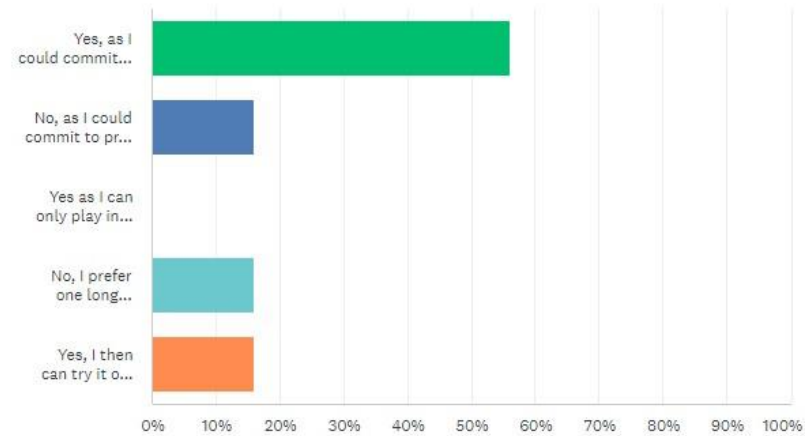


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In your opinion, did splitting the season into pre and post Xmas competitions make it easier to commit to playing senior interclub?

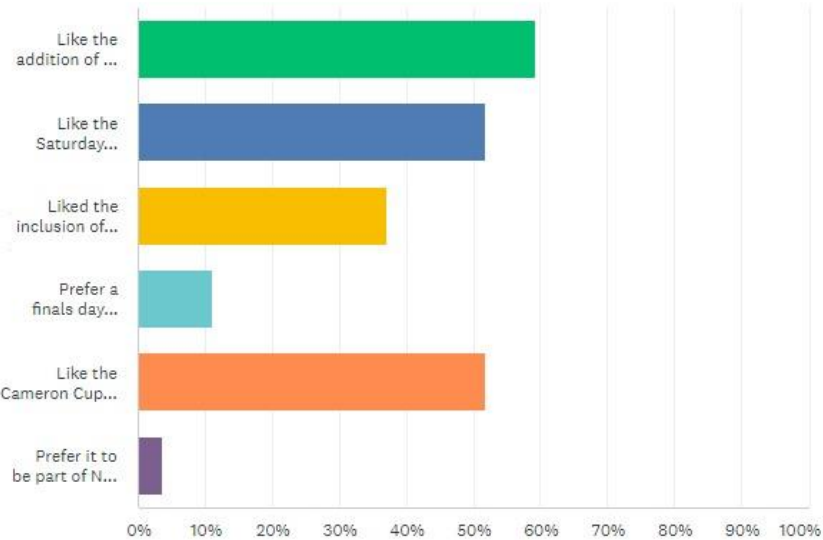



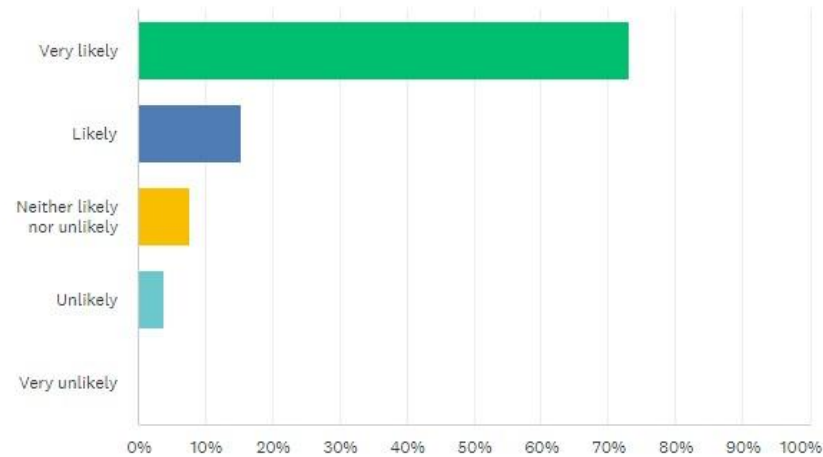


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How likely are you to play in the senior interclub in 2022 -2023?
