WHAT TO BRING: Players must bring their own tennis racquet for the event as well as wear appropriate tennis sporting attire and sports footwear. Players are to bring their own food, water bottle, sunscreen, and hats.

DRAWS AND RESULTS: The results for the championship competitions will be recorded on Match Hub (the Tennis NZ Grading System) The tournament draws will be posted at the venue on the morning of the event. The type of draw depends on the number of entries and is at the discretion of the tournament organiser.

TENNIS RULES: The tournament will be played in accordance with the Rules and Regulations of Tennis NZ

WAITING TIME BETWEEN MATCHES: There can be a lot of waiting around between matches, no players may leave the immediate area of the venue unless they have cleared this with tournament officials. Players must be supervised at all times outside the venue.

PLAYER WITHDRAWALS: No credits (refunds) will be issued for players that pull out after the due date.

SUPERVISION: One Adult is required (per 10 players) for each school attending the competition. Contact details of this/these person/s must be provided on the entry form below.
